### NOTICE OF RACE

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1** The Club Champs will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2** The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3** Appendix T will apply. For protests where only a Rule of Part 2, or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

#### **2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

#### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1** The Club Championship is open to boats of all classes that are sailed by Financial Members of the Manly Sailing Club who will be automatic entries. Non Club members may compete on a daily basis in the "All comers" section of each division.
- 3.2** The age limits for each competitor, entrant and crew members shall be as follows:-

- (a) Open Skiff: As per Class Rules
  - (b) Starling: **Youth**, As per Class Rules
  - (c) Laser Radial: **Youth**, Under 19 as at 31 December 2022  
**Open**, unrestricted
  - (d) Feva: **Youth**, As per Class Rules  
**Open**, unrestricted one or both sailors
  - (e) 29er **Youth**, Both sailors Under 19 as at 31 December 2022
  - (f) Hobie: **Open** Unrestricted
  - (g) Zephyr: **Open** Unrestricted
  - (h) Windfoilers **Open** Unrestricted
- Other classes may be added

#### **4 FEES**

**4.1** Entry for Financial Club members is Free of Charge

**4.2** Required fee for Non Members is \$20 per club day.

#### **5 SCHEDULE**

**5.1** Dates of racing: Five Sundays as below

January 16<sup>th</sup>  
February 13<sup>th</sup>  
February 27<sup>th</sup>  
March 13<sup>th</sup>  
March 27<sup>th</sup>

**5.2** Number of races: Up to Five (5) races may be sailed each day

**5.3** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1255hrs

**5.4** A briefing will be held at 1200hrs each race day.

#### **6 MEASUREMENT**

Class boats shall comply with RRS 78.1 at all times.

#### **7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available online from Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> January 2022

## **8 VENUE**

The racing area is Polkinghorne's Bay/Waiiau Bay Manly Whangaparaoa.

## **9 THE COURSES**

The courses, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left will be advised at the briefing on each Race day.

## **10 PENALTY SYSTEM**

**10.1** The Scoring Penalty, Rule 44.3, will apply. After a protest a boat that is found at fault may be given a discretionary scoring penalty by the protest committee. The scoring penalty shall be no greater than 30% calculated as stated in Rule 44.3

**10.2** For the Open Skiff, Feva and 29er classes RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

## **11 SCORING**

**11.1** a) Non Club Members will be scored in an "All Comers" Class division that will include club members for each class division.  
b) Financial Club Members will be scored separately in each of their Class divisions

**11.2** Twelve (12) races are required to be completed to crown a Club Champion.

### **11.3**

a) When twelve (12) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.  
b) When more than 12 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst three (3) scores.

## **12 SUPPORT BOATS**

Support/Coach boats will be permitted and shall have a working VHF radio for communications with the Race Committee in the event of marginal conditions, sailors in trouble and or injury to sailors.

### 13 PRIZES

At the conclusion of the Club Championship series Medals may be awarded as follows:

Open Skiff Gold	1 <sup>st</sup> ,2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup>
Starling	1 <sup>st</sup> ,2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup>
Laser Radial Youth	1 <sup>st</sup> ,2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup>
Laser Radial Open	1 <sup>st</sup> ,2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup>
Feva Youth	1 <sup>st</sup> ,2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup>
Feva Open	1 <sup>st</sup> ,2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup>
29er	1 <sup>st</sup> ,2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup>
Hobie	1 <sup>st</sup> ,2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup>
Zephyr	1 <sup>st</sup> ,2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup>
Windfoilers	1 <sup>st</sup> ,2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup>

### 14 INSURANCE

Each participating boat is encouraged to be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent..

### 15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
