- On registration support persons will be required to confirm that their vessel has Third Party Liability insurance to the value of NZ\$3,000,000 per incident or equivalent.

Amend 9.3 to read:

9.3. The Organising Authority will provide a limited measurement service to assist competitors needing fundamental measurement of equipment being aware that in some locations access to measurers locally can be difficult. Should competitors require measurement at the event, this will be completed on a first come first served basis and to assist the Measurer, competitors should email mothworlds24@manlysailingclub.org.nz , setting out the scope of measuring required (i.e full boat or specific items). **Competitors should endeavour to have their equipment measured prior to arrival at the venue.**
