NOTICE OF RACE

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The Club Champs will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 Appendix T will apply. For protests where only a Rule of Part 2, or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1
 - (a) The series is open to all boats of the RS Feva class.
 - (b) Club owned boats "**ONLY**" with non "One Design Hyde Sails" may compete providing the sails used are aligned with the Class Rules.
- 3.2 Eligible boats shall enter via www.manlysailingclub.org.nz and completing the online entry form and paying the entry fee of \$80 as described on the website by the closing date 1800hrs Monday 30th September 2019.

3.3 Late entries may be accepted with the additional late entry fee of \$40 up until 1800hrs Thursday 10th October 2019 at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

3.4 The age limits for each competitor, entrant and crew members shall be as follows:-

Junior Both sailors Under 13 as at 31 December 2019

Youth, Both sailors Under 18 as at 31 December 2019

Open, unrestricted one or both sailors

4 FEES

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 A coaching Clinic will take place Friday 11th October 1200 – 1500. An additional charge of \$30 per boat is available to purchase online when entering.

5.2 A briefing will be held at 1000hrs each race day.

5.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1100hrs

5.4 No warning signal will be made after 1530 Sunday 13th October

6 MEASUREMENT

6.1 All boats shall comply with RRS 78.1 at all times.

6.2 Equipment inspection may take place on Saturday 12th October 0900 - 1000

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available online from Thursday 10th October 2019

8 VENUE

The racing area is Polkinghorne's Bay/Waiiau Bay Manly Whangaparaoa.

9 THE COURSES

The courses, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left will be advised at the briefing on each Race day.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 The Scoring Penalty, Rule 44.3, will apply. After a protest a boat that is found at fault may be given a discretionary scoring penalty by the protest committee. The scoring penalty shall be no greater than 30% calculated as stated in Rule 44.3

10.2 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 SCORING

11.1 Eight (8) races are scheduled.

11.2 Five (5) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.3 a) When fewer than six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

b) When six (6) to eight (8) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats are permitted but shall be under the direction of the Race Officer by VHF channel TBA.

13 PRIZES

At the conclusion of series Prizes will be awarded as follows:

- Youth (age <18) 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- Ladies (age <18) 1st
- Mixed (age <18) 1st
- Junior (age <13) 1st
- Open (age 18+) 1st

- First FEVA Regatta (age <18) 1st youth crew attending their first FEVA Traveler Series event

14 INSURANCE

Each participating boat is encouraged to be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent..

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
